Tipp: Mit Stiftwerkzeug und weißer Schriftfarbe kann man auf den Folien „löschen“.

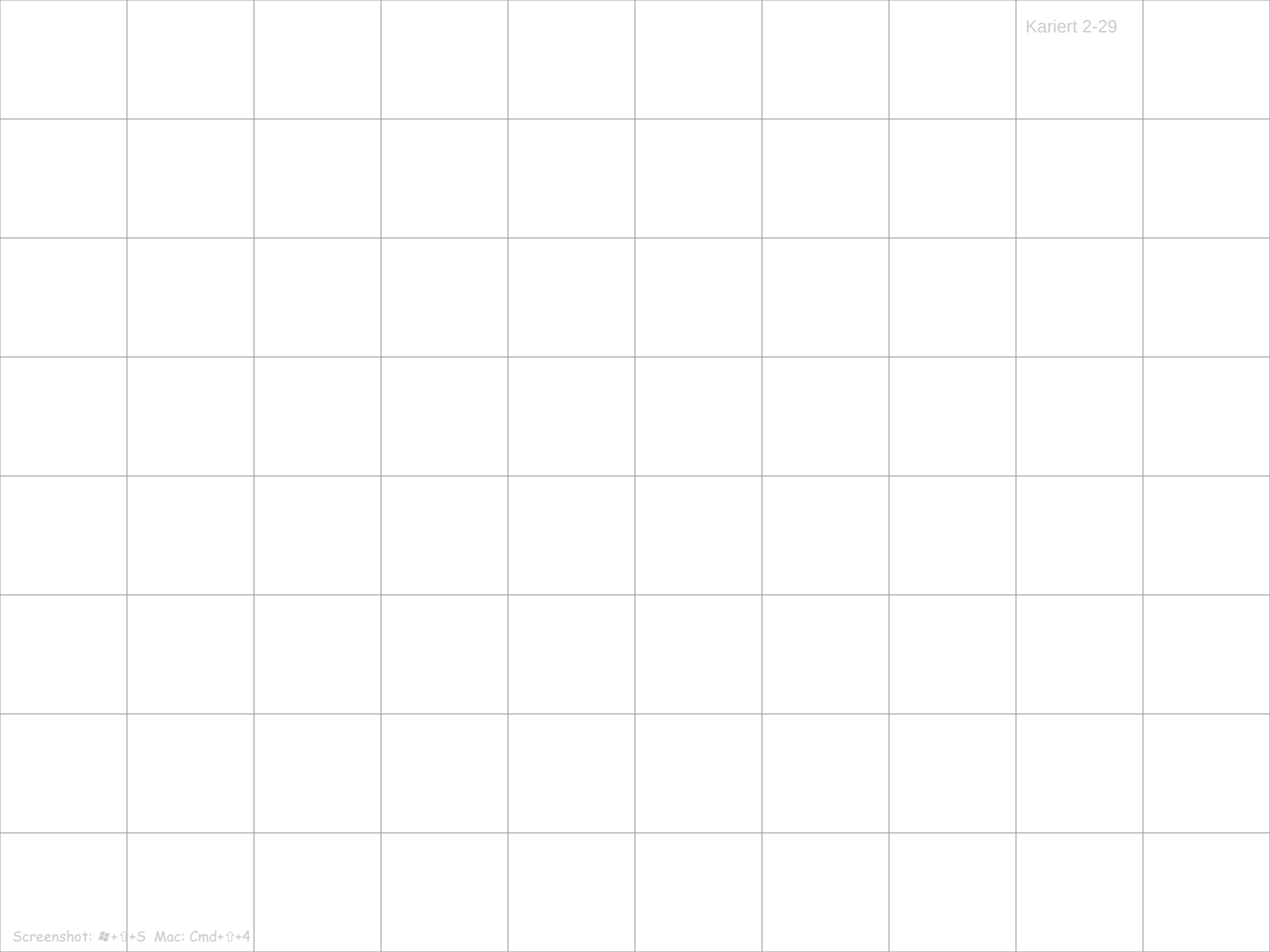








